## STOCK ROAD, IMPROVEMENTS

- 98. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure
- (1) What action has the Government taken to improve Stock Road now that the Fremantle Eastern Bypass is to be deleted?
- (2) If no action has been taken, does the Government have a program and timetable for developing and implementing improvements to Stock Road?
- (3) If yes, what are they?
- When the Fremantle Eastern Bypass is deleted will the proposed Stage 8 section of the Roe Highway be necessary?
- (5) If no, what plans does the Government have for the deletion of the road reserve and sale of land along the proposed Stage 8 section of the Roe Highway?

## Hon G.T. GIFFARD replied:

- (1)-(3) The need to upgrade Stock Road will be considered following completion of the Government's review of the freight network. The purpose of the review is to ensure that freight is moved on the most appropriate and efficient routes, thus meeting the needs of both the community and industry. Arrangements are being made for the freight review to commence later this year and will provide ample opportunity for community input.
- (4)-(5) The review will also consider the need to extend Roe Highway (Stage 8) west of Kwinana Freeway.
