SOUTH WEST ROADS — FUNDING

998. Mr M.P. Murray to the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the section of Albany Highway in the Shire of Wandering and ask:

- (a) what funding was budgeted in 2012–2013 for repairs, upgrades or maintenance to this section of road:
 - (i) if applicable, what specific project is this funding allocation for (e.g. shoulder maintenance, resealing, widening etc.);
 - (ii) if applicable, of the budgeted funds, have any been acquitted; and
 - (iii) if not, why not; and
- (b) is funding proposed for the section of Albany Highway in the Shire of Wandering, in the 2013–2014 Budget:
 - (i) if applicable, how much funding has been allocated and over what time frame;
 - (ii) if applicable, of this funding allocation, what specific projects will be funded; and
 - (iii) if not, why not?

Mr T.R. Buswell replied:

The Main Roads Western Australia advises:

- (a) Other than routine maintenance there was no specific funding allocated to this section of Albany Highway in 2012–13.
