

ROADS TO RECOVERY FUNDING — SOUTH WEST LOCAL GOVERNMENTS

2870. Hon Adele Farina to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) For each 2014–15, 2014–13, 2013–12, 2012–11 and 2011–10, how much Roads to Recovery funding was provided to each South West local government?
- (2) For each 2014–15, 2014–13, 2013–12, 2012–11 and 2011–10, how much road maintenance funding was spent by the State Government in each local government area in the South West region?
- (3) In relation to each of the years stated, and for each local government, what roads were funded and what works were completed?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (1) Main Roads is not responsible for the allocation and distribution of Roads to Recovery funding. This function is provided by the Grants Commission.
- (2)–(3) Main Roads' Maintenance and Financial Management Systems only capture expenditure by region and not local government boundaries.
