GRAHAM FARMER FREEWAY, CYCLEWAYS

756. Hon Tom Stephens to the Minister for Transport:

I refer to cycleways provided in conjunction with the Graham Farmer Freeway and ask -

- (1) What was the total cost of these works?
- (2) How were these valued?
- (3) Were the funds allocated out of the Main Roads Budget provision for Perth Bicycle Network?

Hon M.J. CRIDDLE replied:

- (1) \$4.96 million excluding the path on Windan Bridge.
- (2) Specific cost components identified within the contracts.
- \$2.05 million was funded out of the Graham Farmer Freeway project's contribution towards the Perth Bicycle Network. The remaining funds (\$2.91 million) were provided by Main Roads as part of its commitment to enhancing cycling facilities across the metropolitan area.
