Petition

MR M.P. MURRAY (Collie-Preston) [3.00 pm]: I have a petition that reads as follows —

TO THE HONOURABLE THE SPEAKER AND MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF THE PARLIAMENT OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA IN PARLIAMENT ASSEMBLED.

We, the undersigned, say that Greyhounds WA and Racing and Wagering WA need to immediately undertake scoping and implementation studies to facilitate the development of a greyhound racing track in the South West.

The study should include a location for a race track, along with data that would identify the number of breeders, owners and trainers in the greater South West region with a view of growing the industry in Western Australia.

We now ask the Legislative Assembly to instigate such a study as a matter of urgency.

The petition bears 40 signatures and I certify that it conforms to the standing orders of the Legislative Assembly. [See petition 70.]
