PAUL ALBERT - ADVICE TO MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND TRAINING

900. Mr P.D. OMODEI to the Premier:

Is the Premier saying that Paul Albert lied to the parliamentary inquiry by the Legislative Council committee yesterday?

Mr A.J. CARPENTER replied:

I will answer that in this way: I have been Minister for Education and Training. One of the issues that the current minister has been attacked over is outcomes-based education, under which people are taught to think critically. It was not the model of education when the Leader of the Opposition was at school. That is pretty obvious.
