The Department of Contract and Management Services advised that the figure of \$171 263.50 previously submitted included an amount of \$29 973 in payments made by the State Supply Commission.

The Department of Contract and Management Services has now advised me that the answer to part (a) of question on notice 191 dated 9 August 2000 should read "\$157 254.50". The Department of Contract and Management Services has advised that the figure of \$157 719.50 previously submitted included an amount of \$465 which was a payment made by the State Supply Commission.

The initial figures were due in part to the fact that the Department of Contract and Management Services provides financial services to the State Supply Commission and in part to the fact that both agencies had dealings with the firm Skea, Nelson & Hager in respect of the vehicle fleet funding facility.
