- (3) Has there been a reduction in lanes along William Street?
- (4) If not, when does the Government intend to carry this out?

- (2) This Government has no plans to close the Mitchell Freeway exit to Riverside Drive.

- (4) This Government does not intend reducing the number of lanes in William Street.
