I refer to the Mines Safety and Inspection Act 1994 and reporting requirements by Yancoal Australia Group's Premier Coal mine in Collie, and ask in the last six months:

- (a) in relation to mine site rehabilitation, how many hectares of soil dumps have been revegetated;
- (b) what are the projected hectares of rehabilitated areas for:
 - (i) 2014;
 - (ii) 2015;
 - (iii) 2016;
 - (iv) 2017; and
 - (v) 2018;
- (c) is Yancoal Australia's Premier mine complying with WA State Government requirements rehabilitation guidelines; and
- (d) if not, how far behind is the company in its rehabilitation program?
