520. Mr RIEBELING to the Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Justice:

- (1) I refer to the answer to question on notice No. 2331 of 2000 and ask, how many (if any) extra permanent or temporary positions/employees have been created/employed following the establishment and implementation of the purchaser provider model in the -
 - (a) offender management directorate; and
 - (b) prison services directorate?
- (2) What are these positions?
- (3) What is the cost of these positions?
- (4) Since the creation of the purchase/provider model, what costs have been associated with the employment of-
 - (a) contractors; and
 - (b) consultants,in relation to that model?

Mr BARRON-SULLIVAN replied:

The Minister for Justice has provided the following reply:

- (1) The number of positions created due to the introduction of the purchaser/provider model, 1 March 1999, has been -
 - (a) for Offender Management Directorate, 9.
 - (b) for Prison Services Directorate, Nil.
- (2) Positions created since 1 March 1999 in Offender Management due to the introduction of the Purchaser/Provider model -
