

WAGGRAKINE PRIMARY SCHOOL, MAINTENANCE FUNDING

**601. Hon MURRAY CRIDDLE to the Minister for Education and Training:**

Shane Hill, MLA, wrote a letter to the principal of the Waggrakine Primary School dated 9 October, 2004, confirming that the primary school had been allocated \$185 946 for much-needed maintenance.

- (1) Will the minister confirm that an allocation of \$185 946 has been made to the primary school for school maintenance?
- (2) If yes, when can the primary school expect to receive this allocation?
- (3) Is the minister aware that the delay in receiving these funds, which were needed to replace a leaking roof, has resulted in one injury and is now an occupational safety and health issue?

**Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:**

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) Yes.
- (2) In either 2006-07 or 2007-08, depending on the approved priorities recommended by the Department of Education and Training.
- (3) No. The Department of Education and Training is investigating this issue.
