

HEATHCOTE SITE, LOWER PARKLAND, REZONING

380. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

- (1) Has the Government investigated whether the lower parkland at Heathcote can be rezoned?
- (2) If so, what zoning is being contemplated?
- (3) Has the Government sought advice from the Crown Solicitors Office as to whether the Heathcote Co-ordination Agreement would allow the sale and or the rezoning of the area known as the lower parkland?
- (4) If so, why?
- (5) Has the Government investigated whether it can rezone the lower Parkland area of Heathcote without breaching the Heathcote Co-ordination Agreement it has made with the Melville City Council?

Hon GRAHAM GIFFARD replied:

The Government has not made a decision on the future of the Lower land.
