SUBURBAN TRAINS — CLAISEBROOK DEPOT

262. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) How many A-series trains are currently stored at the Claisebrook depot each night?
- (2) Where are the remainder of the A-series trains stored each night?
- (3) Currently, what is the maximum number of A-series trains that can be stored overnight at the Claisebrook depot?

Hon JIM CHOWN replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1) Forty-four A-series trains are currently stored at the Claisebrook depot each night.
- (2) The remainder of the A-series trains are stored at the Nowergup depot.
- (3) Although 48 A-series trains is the maximum number of trains that can be stored at Claisebrook depot overnight, this number does not allow for the efficient movement and operation of trains given the depot's current layout.
