

PORT COOGEE, AUSTRALAND PROJECT, REPORT

2003. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure
In relation to an Ernst and Young financial report on the Australand Port Coogee project -

- (1) When did the Minister refer the Ernst and Young report to a Government Agency for assessment?
- (2) Which Government Agency was the report referred to?
- (3) Has the Minister received back an assessment of the Ernst and Young report?
- (4) If yes, can the Minister detail the findings of that assessment?
- (5) Will the Minister table the report by Ernst and Young on the Australand development at Port Coogee and the Government Agencies findings?

Hon KEN TRAVERS replied:

- (1)-(5) A copy of the Ernst & Young "Review of Feasibility Analysis Considering Scenarios for the Port Coogee Development" was officially referred to the Minister under a covering letter dated 16 March 2004.

A copy of this report was made available to senior staff at LandCorp and Treasury for examination and discussion. A copy of LandCorp's report is tabled. Advice is being sought on the appropriateness of tabling the Ernst and Young report as it contains commercially sensitive information. [See paper No 2309.]
