Mr Johnson present the following petition bearing the signatures of 52 persons -

To the Honourable the Speaker and members of the Legislative Assembly in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, have experienced problems for many years with noise coming from traffic along the access road at the above site, and with noise coming from the existing leasee's premises. In addition, if the Water Corporation proceeds with plans to lease a further portion of the Beenyup site, residents will be further inconvenienced. Therefore, residents should be protected from noise pollution, both existing and in the future, through the construction of a suitable acoustic barrier close to and for the entire length of the Western perimeter of the old depot site. This should be out of the view of the residences, and should be a condition of the continued lease arrangements.

Your petitioners therefore humbly pray that you will give this matter your earnest consideration and your petitioners, as in duty bound, will ever pray.
