Recreation Facilities in the Warren Area

We the undersigned call on the State Government to provide appropriate funds to ensure that people in the Warren area, which encompasses all of the Manjimup Shire receive a fair allocation of state funds for sport and recreation which would be equal to facilities that exist in regional centres and the metropolitan area.

The lack of a heated pool, in a town which services a large inland region and a large number of incoming tourists is not acceptable in this day and age.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to advise the Government of our concerns about being treated equally with our city counterparts and ask that funds be set aside for recreation facilities in the Manjimup Shire and further that the first priority should be a heated pool complex which would serve all of the people of the lower south west.
