

HIGH STREET-STIRLING HIGHWAY, FREMANTLE, TURNING LANES

1048. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure

In question on notice No. 286 of October 23 2002 the Minister said that the intersection at High Street/Stirling Highway Fremantle would be altered to allow two turning lanes from High Street into Stirling Highway -

- (1) Has this been done?
- (2) If not, why not?
- (3) Given the strong concern about this intersection what priority is the Minister giving to this issue?

Hon KEN TRAVERS replied:

- (1)-(3) In line with the Government's decision to delete the Fremantle Eastern Bypass from the Metropolitan Region Scheme, the Local Impacts Committee is currently investigating alternative design options for the configuration of this intersection.
