800. Hon MURRAY CRIDDLE to the Minister for the Midwest and Wheatbelt:

Geraldton is in urgent need of a marine services precinct and associated 200-tonne boat lifter to support its marine industry. The federal government has now committed \$1.078 million and a local industry consortium has agreed to contribute \$500 000. When will the state government make a commitment to contribute \$1.5 million so that this project can go ahead?
