

MAIN ROADS WESTERN AUSTRALIA, FUNDING

**1552. Hon MURRAY CRIDDLE to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:**

- (1) How much state funding has been allocated to Main Roads Western Australia in this year's state budget?
- (2) What is the source of those funds?
- (3) How much federal funding is in the state budget?
- (4) How much loan funding is in the Main Roads budget?
- (5) How much money will go directly to local government in 2002-03, 2003-04 and 2004-05?

**Hon GRAHAM GIFFARD replied:**

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) The amount is \$569.414 million.
- (2) The source of the state funding included in the Main Roads budget is consolidated fund, \$567.414 million, and road trauma trust fund, \$2 million.
- (3) Federal funds amounting to \$87.810 million have been included in the Main Roads budget.
- (4) It is estimated that total accumulated borrowings as at 30 June 2003 will amount to \$338.093 million.
- (5) Under the state road funds to local government agreement, the following state funds will be provided for expenditure on local roads: 2002-03, \$100.024 million; 2003-04, \$86.564 million; and 2004-05, \$95.149 million.
