

ABORIGINAL CULTURAL HERITAGE ACT — PREMIER'S COMMENTS

469. Dr D.J. HONEY to the Premier:

I have a supplementary question. Why will the Premier not show true leadership and apologise for using such offensive language against the opposition in this debate?

Mr R.H. COOK replied:
