We the undersigned believe that the Government's Electoral Amendment bill is unfair and divisive in transferring eight districts from country Western Australia to the metropolitan area. This would leave 15 of 57 members of the Legislative Assembly to represent 99% of our State's land area.

We ask the Government to either withdraw this Bill or to submit it to the vote of all Western Australian electors in a democratic referendum.
