PERTH PARKING MANAGEMENT AMENDMENT BILL 2023

Introduction and First Reading

MS R. SAFFIOTI (West Swan — Minister for Transport) [10.36 am]: I move —

That the bill be now read a second time.

I am pleased to introduce the Perth Parking Management Amendment Bill 2023. This bill is to be considered in conjunction with the Perth Parking Management Bill 2023. Once passed, this amendment bill will amend section 145 of the Perth Parking Management Act 2023 to provide that, to the extent that a fee imposed under that bill is a tax, the fee is imposed.

Section 46(7) of the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899 requires a separate bill to impose such a fee, and this is that bill.

I commend this bill to the house and I table a copy of the explanatory memorandum.
