

GRAIN TRAIN — DERAILMENT

I refer to the derailment of a grain train on the York–Quairading line on September 2013.

- (1) Has the Office of Rail Safety completed its investigation?
- (2) If yes, will the minister table the report?

- (1) The Office of Rail Safety issued terms of reference to WATCO WA Rail and Brookfield Rail on 25 September 2013 to conduct a joint investigation. This is the standard practice and is done in accordance with the Rail Safety Act 2010. The investigation report has not been completed.
