

ROCKINGHAM CITY COUNCIL, HEIGHT RESTRICTION POLICY

**501. Hon JIM SCOTT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:**

- (1) When was the proposal for the Ramada development first raised with Rockingham City Council officers?
- (2) What was the height limit for developments in Rockingham at that time?
- (3) When was the 15-metre height restriction deleted from the City of Rockingham planning policy?
- (4) Which decision-making body is responsible for the deletion of the 15-metre high restriction, and which members of that body were present at the time that decision was made?

**Hon GRAHAM GIFFARD replied:**

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1) The development application was signed on 14 September 2001. It is not known when the proposal was first with officers prior to that date.
- (2) There was no height limit in September 2001.
- (3) 27 April 1999.
- (4) The City of Rockingham was therefore responsible for the deletion of the height limit. It is not known which council members were present when that decision was made in April 1999.
