THIRD AVENUE AND SEVENTH AVENUE BRIDGES — MT LAWLEY

523. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the rebuilding of the Third Avenue and Seventh Avenue bridges over the railway in Mt Lawley.

- (1) Will the width of the new bridges be sufficient to allow for additional rail lines to be built under them?
- (2) If yes, how many additional lines will they allow for?
- (3) If no, why not?
- (4) Will the clearance height under the Seventh Avenue bridge be increased?
- (5) If yes, by how much?

- (5) The clearance between the track and the new bridge will be increased by 200 millimetres to 5.4 metres.
