## Petition

MR W.J. JOHNSTON (Cannington) [3.07 pm]: I present a petition signed by 46 people —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, say

- 1. That the Beckenham Primary School Out of School Care service will close if the State Government removes the transportable classroom from which it operates at the end of the term, and
- 2. That the closure of this facility will disadvantage the 110 children and 78 families who use this service.

Now we ask that the Legislative Assembly

- 1. Recognise the negative impact it will have on the school community and local families,
- 2. Allow the transportable classroom to stay for the next 12 months to allow the local community to develop a long-term plan to secure this service.
