- (c) What is the current number of available residential rehabilitation beds, by region;
- (d) What was the number of available residential rehabilitation beds, by region, for each of the past five years;
- (e) What is the current wait time for an available residential rehabilitation bed, by region;
- (f) What was the average wait time for an available residential rehabilitation bed, by region, for each of the past five years;
- (g) What is the current number of available low medical withdrawal beds per 100,000 people in Western Australia;
- (h) What was the number of available low medical withdrawal beds per 100,000 people in Western Australia, for each of the past five years;
- (i) What is the current number of available low medical withdrawal beds, by region;
- (j) What was the number of available low medical withdrawal beds, by region, for each of the past five years;
- (k) What is the current wait time for an available low medical withdrawal bed, by region; and
- (l) What was the average wait time for an low medical withdrawal bed, by region, for each of the past five years?
