

RAIL LINES — BUTLER EXTENSION BUDGET

2533. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

How much of the \$240 million budget for the Butler rail extension was spent on:

- (a) works at the Mandurah Depot and what were the works; and
- (b) works at the Nowergup Depot and what were the works?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a) \$11.61 million has been spent on works at the Mandurah Depot. These works are:

Track works, overhead line works, civil works and signalling works to expand capacity.

Provision of railcar inspection and cleaning facilities.

- (b) \$27.05 million has been spent on works at Nowergup Depot. These works are:

Track works, overhead line works, civil works, signalling, communications and electrical works to expand capacity and improve operational flexibility.

Provision of a new arch underpass and access road into the depot.

Provision of new security fencing at the depot.
