GOVERNMENT VEHICLES, NUMBER LEASED AND OWNED

816. Hon Norm Kelly to the Minister for Transport representing the Minister for Aboriginal Affairs:

As of June 30 2000, for all agencies under the control of the Minister for

Aboriginal Affairs, can you advise -

- (1) How many vehicles are leased or owned by those agencies?
- (2) Of these, how many are -
 - (a) passenger vehicles; and
 - (b) commercial vehicles?
- (3) Of the total number of vehicles, how many are -
 - (a) petrol or diesel powered;
 - (b) LPG powered; and
 - (c) powered by other means?
- (4) What actions have these agencies taken to increase the proportion of vehicles using Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG)?

Hon M.J. CRIDDLE replied:

- (1) 60.
- (2) (a) 36.
 - (b) 24.
- (3) (a) 60.
 - (b-c) Nil.
- (4) To date it has not been cost beneficial to acquire LPG units particularly with the limited supply in regional and remote areas of the State. However the Aboriginal Affairs Department will evaluate the LPG option with all its new and replacement vehicles in response to the State Government's initiative in this area.
