## 320. Hon JIM SCOTT to the minister representing the Minister for the Environment and Heritage:

This is a question without notice of which some notice has been given.

- (1) How many air quality monitoring stations are in place around the Cockburn Cement facility?
- (2) Where are these stations located in relation to the stacks?
- (3) Referring to the amateur video film shown on the media indicating ash raining in Cockburn, has the minister spoken to the person who filmed the ash?
- (4) If so, will the minister please give details?
- (5) Given that the Department of Environmental Protection is saying that pollution limits were not exceeded, how does the minister reconcile this with the video footage and personal experience of the people of Cockburn?
