- (1) What has the Minister done to implement her election promise to introduce annual environmental performance reporting for all Government agencies?
- (2) Where are these reports available to the public?
- (3) Are all Government agencies now complying with this policy?
- (4) Which Government agencies are not complying with this policy?

Hon TOM STEPHENS replied:

The Minister for the Environment provided the following response:

(1)-(4) The commitment of agencies to environmental reporting will be part of the Sustainability Action Plans of all agencies. These will be prepared by all agencies from 2004. Details are provided in the State Sustainability Strategy. Some agencies have already been moving to report on their environmental performance. The overall environmental performance of the State Government will be part of the State of Sustainability Report that is also part of the State Sustainability Strategy.
