

PUBLIC TRANSPORT — BUS ROUTES AND FREQUENCY

1735. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) What are the 166 standard routes on which accessible buses are always used?
- (2) What are the major corridors on which a bus service frequency of 15 minutes or better is provided all day?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

Note that Transperth endeavours to provide an accessible bus on the above mentioned bus routes, unless specifically identified on the timetable, or in the unlikely event of a breakdown where a replacement accessible bus cannot be sourced in time.

- (2) The following main roads are served by a High Frequency bus service:

Please note: Routes shown together operate as a “pair”. Neither route would operate every 15 minutes interpeak, but when combined with their partner, they provide a 15 minute service or better.

Cambridge Street (to Harborne Street) — approximately every 5 minutes peak/10 minutes interpeak (Routes 81, 82, 83, 84 and 85).

Scarborough Beach Road (Scarborough to Glendalough) — approximately every 5 minutes peak/7–8 minutes interpeak (Route 990).

Wanneroo Road (to Amelia Street) — approximately every 5 minutes peak/10 minutes interpeak (Routes 386, 387, 388 and 389).

Flinders Street — approximately every 5–10 peak/7–8 minutes interpeak (Routes 354, 370 and 870).

Alexander Drive (to Morley Drive) — approximately every 3 minutes peak/every 10 minutes interpeak (Routes 885, 886, 887, 888 and 889).

William Street — approximately every 3–5 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 16 and 60).

Beaufort Street — approximately every 1–3 minutes peak/every 5–7 minutes interpeak (Routes 66, 67, 68 and 950).

Guildford Road (to Peninsula Road) — approximately every 5 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 41, 42, 48 and 55).

Great Eastern Highway — approximately every 5 minutes peak/every 10 minutes interpeak (Routes 36, 40, 295, 296 and 299).

Shepperton Road — approximately every 3–5 minutes peak/every 5–8 minutes interpeak (Routes 38, 210, 211, 212, 282, 283 and 298).

Albany Highway Inner — approximately every 5 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 170, 176, 177, 179 and 220).

Albany Highway Outer (to Carousel) — approximately every 5 minutes peak/every 7–8 minutes interpeak (Routes 210, 211, 212 and 220).

Canning Highway — approximately every 5 minutes peak / every 15 interpeak (some segments receive an average of 510 min interpeak) (Routes 104, 105, 106, 111).

Marmion Street — approximately every 10 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Route 501).

South Street/Ranford Road (to Livingston) — approximately every 5 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 204, 205, 206, 207, 517, 518, 519).

Labouchere Road — approximately every 5 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 30 and 31).

Altone Road/Lord Street (Bassendean to Ellenbrook) — approximately every 10 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 955 and 956).

Beechboro Road — approximately every 10–15 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 343 and 345).

Warnbro Sound Avenue (to Secret Harbour Boulevard North) — approximately every 10 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 558, 559 and 561).

Marmion Avenue (to Santa Barbara Parade) — approximately every 10 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 480 and 482).

Berwick/Etwell Streets (Perth to Curtin) — approximately every 5 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 72 and 75).

Loftus Street — approximately every 5 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 402, 403 and 404).

Amelia Street (Stirling to Mirrabooka) — approximately every 10 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Route 415).

Yirrigan Drive (Morley to Warwick) — approximately every 10–15 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Route 371).

Barnes Road (to Huntriss Rd) — approximately every 5–10 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 421 and 423).

Candlewood Boulevard/ Joondalup Drive (to Wanneroo Road) — approximately every 5–10 minutes peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 390 and 391).

Kooyong Road — approximately every 5 minutes peak/every 10 minutes interpeak (Route 37).

The CircleRoute service — approximately every 10–15 min peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Routes 98 and 99).

The Rockingham City Centre Transit services — approximately every 15 minutes in peak/every 15 minutes interpeak (Route 555).

Routes which are operating on an average 15 minute frequency or better all day:
