## PYRTON SITE, DEVELOPMENT PROPOSALS

## 969. Hon JIM SCOTT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

- (1) Can the minister inform the House which government agencies currently retain ownership or management responsibilities for the Pyrton site in Bassendean?
- (2) Is the Government considering or preparing any development proposals for the Pyrton site?
- (3) If yes, can she identify the proponents and details of the development proposals?
- (4) With each development proposal can she indicate if it will be -
  - (a) residential,
  - (b) commercial, or
  - (c) industrial?
- (5) What guarantees can the minister provide that indigenous groups will have joint management of any development at the Pyrton site and access to their culturally significant locations?
