

RAIL NETWORK — SEA CONTAINERS — MANDURAH DEPOT

2727. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) What is the purpose of the sea-containers located at the Mandurah rail depot?
- (2) How long have they been located at this site?
- (3) Who owns the sea-containers?
- (4) Is there any plant equipment located at the Mandurah rail depot that has been hired by the Public Transport Authority?
- (5) If yes to (4):
  - (a) what is the purpose of the equipment;
  - (b) how long has this equipment been located on site;
  - (c) what is the cost of the equipment; and
  - (d) when will the equipment be returned?

**Hon Jim Chown replied:**

- (1) One sea container, a transportable office and a trailer mounted generator for power to the office is being used by the Public Transport Authority's Signals Contractor, Ansaldo STS for the construction of a crossover at the southern end of the Mandurah rail depot.

- (3) The sea container is owned by Coates Hire and was hired by Ansaldo STS.
