

QUEEN ELIZABETH II MEDICAL CENTRE — PROPOSED CAR PARK

1336. Hon NEIL THOMSON to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Health:

I refer to the proposed 1 900-car bay car park that is planned for Monash Avenue at the Queen Elizabeth II Medical Centre site in Nedlands.

- (1) Is the state government still committed to the project?
- (2) When will construction begin on the project?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1)–(2) The government remains committed to delivering additional parking at Queen Elizabeth II Medical Centre where possible. Given the former Liberal–National government’s privatisation of parking services at the site and the restrictive contract that caps the number of bays, it is a complex matter.
