

ENVIRONMENT — DRAFT FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN 2014–2023

1005. Mr M.P. Murray to the Minister for Environment:

I refer to the *Draft Forest Management Plan 2014–2023*, prepared by the Conservation Commission, through the former Department of Environment and Conservation, and ask:

- (a) are any members of the Conservation Commission, who helped prepare the *Draft Forest Management Plan 2014–2023*, directly or indirectly associated with the timber or mining sectors:
 - (i) if yes, what are these individual's names and their position within the Conservation Commission; and
 - (ii) if yes, did such Conservation Commission members declare or disclose their indirect or pecuniary interests during the preparation of the *Draft Forest Management Plan 2014–2023*?

Mr A.P. Jacob replied:

I am advised of the following by the Conservation Commission of Western Australia.

- (a) Yes.
 - (i) Mr Wade de Campo and Dr Steve Harvey are associated with the timber or mining sectors. Mr de Campo and Dr Harvey are members of the Conservation Commission of Western Australia.
 - (ii) Mr de Campo declared a conflict of interest related to his position as President of the Shire of Manjimup and excused himself from discussions involving the preparation of the *Forest Management Plan 2014–2023*. Dr Harvey did not identify any conflict of interests and as such no declarations were made.
