

BICYCLE NETWORK PLAN — BASSENDEAN TO MIDLAND LINK

1831. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the Western Australia Bicycle Network Plan and ask, for the priority link Perth to Midland Railway Line from Bassendean to Midland:

- (a) what planning work has been done on this link;
- (b) what are the details of the works required;
- (c) when does the Minister expect work to commence;
- (d) when does the Minister expect works to be completed;
- (e) what is the estimated cost of this project; and
- (f) how much is currently allocated in the 2014–15 State Budget and in each year of the forward estimates?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a)–(b) It is proposed to install a Principal Shared Path and associated structures. Planning works include:
 - concept design.
 - detailed design.
 - and alignment review.
- (c)–(d) Works are currently underway with the final section to be completed in 2017.
- (e) The cost estimate for remaining works will be developed after the design has been completed.
- (f) \$12.63m for the current projects.
