From the outset, I would like to thank the minister's advisers for providing background information that has assisted the opposition in our deliberations on the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law Application Bill 2023. We understand that this legislation is important in ensuring there is some consistency with other states. It will provide benefits for health practitioners who work between states or interstate. It still recognises the unique differences in the Western Australian jurisdiction, as supported by the health community in WA—that is, when health practitioners seek medical or mental health support.
