Appropriations

Message from the Governor received and read recommending appropriations for the purposes of the Bill.

Second Reading

Resumed from an earlier stage of the sitting.

MR KIERATH (Riverton - Minister for Planning) [4.22 pm]: I have received the information requested by the Opposition regarding the number of first home owner grant scheme applications from 1 July to 30 September 2000. In July 2000, the Government received 1 540 applications and paid 408 grants. In August, it received 1 837 applications and paid 1 460 grants. In September, 1 450 applications were received and 1 271 grants were paid. Those numbers peaked in August and then dropped back. For the year to date, 4 827 applications were received and 3 139 grants were paid. Those figures indicate that the peak has been reached. I hope that satisfies the Opposition's request for information. I commend the Bill to the House.

Question put and passed.

Bill read a second time, proceeded through remaining stages without debate, and transmitted to the Council.
