

HOMELESSNESS — ENTRYPOINT PERTH

213. Hon WILSON TUCKER to the minister representing the Minister for Homelessness:

I refer to my previous questions 169 and 199 regarding the funding of Entrypoint Perth.

- (1) Does the government collect operational metrics for Entrypoint, such as key performance or key effectiveness indicators?
- (2) If yes to (1), what are the indicators, the targets and the actuals?
- (3) If no to (1), why not?

Hon JACKIE JARVIS replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. The following response has been provided by the Minister for Homelessness.

- (1)–(3) Entrypoint Perth is contracted by the WA state government to provide a free assessment and referral service statewide. It is available to assist people who are homeless or at risk of homelessness, including individuals and families escaping domestic violence, to access a range of accommodation and support options. Entrypoint does not have any specific key performance indicators as part of its contract.
