3031. Hon Ken Travers to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the proposed trench from Cannington Road to Stirling Highway as part of the Perth Freight Link project, and I ask:

- (a) will the High Street upgrade be six or four lanes wide;
- (b) will the upgrade include breakdown emergency lanes; and
- (c) will placarded loads be permitted to travel in the trench?

Hon Jim Chown replied:

- (a) The current concept design for the Perth Freight Link, where it is adjacent to High Street (between Carrington Street and Stirling Highway), includes a trench with four lanes of traffic.
- (b) No, however, emergency stopping bays will be provided along the Perth Freight Link.
- (c) Yes.
