1200. Hon J.A. SCOTT to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for State Development:

Further to question without notice 1041 of 21 February 2002 regarding the total cost to the State of the Jervois Bay southern harbour project -

- (1) Of the estimated total cost of \$47 million, how much money has been allocated to new roads in and around the port; and how much money has been allocated to the realignment of roads in and around the port?
- (2) Do these funds come from the main roads budget; and, if not, how are these roads funded?

Hon KEN TRAVERS replied:

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) Nil. Under the agreement with the federal Government, internal roads are funded from the Federation Fund grant.
- (2) The realignment of Cockburn Road was funded from the Main Road budget.
