QUAIRADING-CUNDERDIN ROAD — GRAIN TRANSPORT

837. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to question without notice 780.

- (1) Has Main Roads advised the Shire of Quairading that it has three options regarding the culvert on the Cunderdin–Quairading Road?
- (2) Was the first option to place a six-tonne load limit over the culvert?
- (3) Was the second option to repair or strengthen the culvert?
- (4) Was the third option to replace the culvert?
- (5) Will the state government fund the second or third options?
- (6) If no to (5), how does the minister expect grain trucks—RAV 4/5—to use this road?

Hon JIM CHOWN replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1)–(5) Yes, the third option is included in the proposed realignment being funded under the grain freight program.
- (6) Not applicable.
