## ORGAN DONATION, PRE-TRANSPLANT TESTING

- 1453. Hon Jim Scott to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Health
- (1) What pre-transplant testing is carried out on donated organs or their donors?
- (2) Are donated kidneys or their donors screened for Cytomegalovirus (CMV)?
- (3) If not, why not?

## Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

- (1) The TSANZ (Transplant Society of Australia and New Zealand) guidelines require that the following investigations are completed by a TGA (Therapeutic Goods Administration) accredited laboratory, which in Western Australia is the PathCentre at Sir Charles Gairdner Hospital and Royal Perth Hospital laboratories.
  - $\cdot$  Blood group for ABO and rhesus factor
  - · HIV antibody
  - · Hepatitis B surface antigen
  - · Hepatitis B core IgG antibody
  - · Hepatitis C antibody
  - · Epstein Barr Virus capsid IgG antibody
  - · Beta Human Chorionic Gonadotropin Hormone in females of child bearing age dying from undiagnosed intracerebral haemorrhage
  - · Cytomegalovirus IgG antibody
  - · HTLV I and II antibody
  - · Human leucocyte antigen tissue typing and panel reactive antibodies
