4366. Hon Murray Criddle to the Minister for Education and Training

- (1) Did the Corruption and Crime Commission instigate the inquiry into the Department of Education regarding allegations of sexual misconduct of some teachers?
- (2) If no to (1), did the Department of Education invite the Corruption and Crime Commission to carry out the inquiry?
- (3) Did the Director General inform the Minister of the Corruption and Crime Commission's involvement with the Department of Education?
- (4) Did any member of the Minister's office staff have any knowledge of the Corruption and Crime Commission's inquiry before the report was presented on 12 October 2006?

Hon LJILJANNA RAVLICH replied:

- (1)-(4) These questions are covered by the Terms of Reference of the Department of Education and Training Select Committee which is scheduled to Report on December 7th.
