

CITY OF STIRLING, RESOURCE RECOVERY REBATE SCHEME

835. Hon Jim Scott to the Minister for Housing and Works representing the Minister for the Environment and Heritage

(1) How much funding did the City of Stirling budget receive for the Resource Recovery Rebate Scheme in -

- (a) 1999;
- (b) 2000;
- (c) 2001; and
- (d) 2002 budget years?

(2) How much did they receive from the rebate in those years?

Hon TOM STEPHENS replied:

The Minister for the Environment has provided the following response:

(1) The Resource Recovery Rebate Scheme is allocated half of the landfill levy revenue collected. The total amount of this money is distributed to claiming councils half-yearly on the basis of their recycling performance and is paid in arrears. The amount paid is based on an assessment of their claim and is in proportion to their share of the total local government recycling effort.
