

BROOKTON HIGHWAY BETWEEN KONDININ AND CORRIGIN, ROAD WORK DELAYS

1681. Hon MURRAY CRIDDLE to the parliamentary secretary representing the Minister for Planning and Infrastructure:

- (1) Is there a delay in the commencement of roadworks in the Gorge Rock area of the Brookton Highway between Kondinin and Corrigin?
- (2) If so, why?
- (3) What is the budget for this work?
- (4) If this work is not done, will the money be used for any other sections of this road?
- (5) If not, where will the money be spent?

- (2) An environmental appeal has been lodged relating to the removal of vegetation.
- (3) \$1 million.
- (4) Yes. The funds have been transferred to the Karlgarin to Hyden section of Brookton Highway and these works are currently in progress.
