## GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS IN EXCESS OF \$5 000

120. Mr P.D. Omodei to the Minister for Consumer and Employment Protection; Indigenous Affairs; Minister Assisting the Minister for Water Resources

Will the Minister provide details of all contracts undertaken by the Minister's office since 1 January 2004 that exceed \$5000, including but not limited to -

- (a) the purpose of the contract; and
- (b) the final total cost of the contract?

## Mr J.C. KOBELKE replied:

Most ministerial office services are under contracts entered into by the other Departments not the Minister's office. Contracts entered into by the Minister's office, and the details relating to them, are published in the Report on Consultants engaged by Government for the six months which are tabled in the Parliament. Should the Member require any more specific details relating to any such contract I will seek to provide the information.
