## PRINCESS MARGARET HOSPITAL SITE — REDEVELOPMENT

## 767. Hon NEIL THOMSON to the minister representing the Minister for Lands:

I refer to question without notice 460, which provided site-specific transport modelling but no local network scale transport modelling associated with the development of the former Princess Margaret Hospital for Children.

- (1) Why has there not been local network scale transport modelling on the impacts of the 1 435 new car bays being proposed on the site?
- (2) Has any assessment of future transport demands been made on likely increased peak time travel times on Thomas Street?
- (3) Will development at the PMH site impact on travel times between Fiona Stanley Hospital and Perth Children's Hospital?
- (4) If yes to (3), what is the expected increase in travel time between Fiona Stanley and the Perth Children's Hospital at peak times after the development is completed?

## Hon JACKIE JARVIS replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. The following response has been provided by the Minister for Lands.

- (1)–(2) As was provided to the Parliament on 10 May 2023, through question on notice 460, modelling has been undertaken.
- (3) No. The shortest route between Fiona Stanley Hospital and Perth Children's Hospital does not include a deviation to the north of both sites, via the former Princess Margaret Hospital site.
