

SOUTH BEACH VILLAGE, SITE INVESTIGATION AND MANAGEMENT PLAN

1255. Hon Jim Scott to the Minister for Local Government and Regional Development representing the Minister for the Environment

- (1) Has the developer of the South Beach Village prepared a Site Investigation and Management Plan for the ANI Bradkin site?
- (2) If yes, will the Minister table the document?
- (3) If the developer has not developed a Site Investigation and Management Plan for the ANI Bradken site is the Minister aware that a plan was to be prepared prior to subdivision?
- (4) Is the Minister aware that subdivision plans for the former ANI Bradken site have been lodged?

Hon TOM STEPHENS replied:

The Minister for the Environment has provided the following response:

- (1) Yes. The developer has prepared the Site Investigation and Management Plan for the ANI Bradken site, which has been reviewed by the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), the Department of Health and the Department of Planning and Infrastructure (DPI).
- (2) Yes. After receiving approval from the developer, a copy of the Site Investigation and Management Plan is tabled for your information. I am aware that the developer is prepared to provide copies of reports to interested parties if approached. [See paper No 1561.]
- (3) Not applicable.
- (4) Yes, I am aware that a subdivision application has been lodged with the DPI, which is in the process of considering it, in accordance with the environmental conditions of the Ministerial Statement for the site.
